DOWNLOAD APPLICATION

Follow this procedure to download the latest PC Suite from <https://www.supercharge.com.au/resources/accessories> or following this link diagup.me/marshallpower

Download and install the application suite using the application suite user guide for help if required.

Once the suite is installed you simply need to follow the steps shown on screen to update the handset to the latest software.

Minimum requirements:

Windows PC running Windows XP/Vista/7/8

5MB of free disk space


INSTALLATION PROCEDURE

Follow this procedure if you are installing the BRT-12 PC Suite for the first time. If you experience problems with the installation then please ensure you have Administrator rights on your PC. If you are still experiencing problems then please use the web form on the website to contact us.


When you run the installer you are presented with a User Account Control message warning you that the application you are installing will make changes to your computer. It is imperative to ensure that you have Administrator rights on the PC before continuing


Wait while the PC prepares to install.
- 03**




After you have run the BRT-12 suite application, the 'Welcome to the 'BRT-12 Setup Wizard' will be displayed, select 'Next'.
- 04**



The 'Select installation Folder' screen will appear, accept the folder if appropriate and select 'Next'.
- 05**




When the 'Confirm Installation' screen appears select 'Next'.
- 06**



The 'Installing Exide BRT-12 Suite' screen will be launched, once the software has been successfully installed select 'Next'.
- 07**



As this is the first time that your BRT-12 has been connected to your PC, the 'Device Driver Installation Wizard' popup will be displayed.
- 08**



The installation will take a short time to complete; the screen below will be displayed during this process.


Your PC may give you a warning saying the Publisher is unknown. Select 'Install the driver software anyway' to accept the changes that will be made.
- 10**



The 'Completing the Device Driver Installation Wizard' screen is displayed, when your BRT-12 has been detected. Select 'Finish'.
- 11**



You will see the screen 'Installation Complete' that confirms that the installation was successful, select 'Close'.
- 12**



Run the BRT-12 Suite Application from the start menu, select 'Start' – 'Programs' – 'Marshall Power' – 'BRT-12 Suite'. [There will also be an icon installed onto your desktop].

REGISTRATION PROCEDURE

01



Read the Privacy Policy and accept before continuing.

02



Connect the USB cable supplied to the BRT-12 and then to a USB port on the PC. A main USB port (on the rear of the PC) as opposed to an extension (on the front of the PC) is preferable.

03




The Driver should indicate that it is fully installed and ready to use. If this does not happen, go to the Installing Driver section.

When you press the 'Next' button, the BRT-12 will be detected by the BRT-12 Suite.

05




The Suite will then check the internet connection is present. If you experience problems at this point you will be directed to the Tests & Checks section of the BRT-12 Suite.

Complete the 'Product Registration' ensuring you complete all sections marked with a '*'. Once complete press the 'Next' button.



Once the information has been submitted, the Subscription Number, Postcode, Email address and subscription expiry date will be displayed back. Although these details are stored on your PC, it would be worthwhile making a note of these details in case you require them in the future.


UPDATE PROCEDURE

01



Run the BRT-12 Suite Application From the start menu, select 'Start' – 'All Programs' – 'Marshall Power' – 'BRT-12 Suite'. (There will also be an icon installed onto your desktop).

Select the option 'Get BRT-12 Updates'.

03




